FY21 Accomplishments





Evolving the network

FirstNet Authority investments delivered access to AT&T 5G and expanded the fleet of deployables by 15 assets

Launched and evolved mission ready tools, such as Z-axis, HPUEs, Compact Rapid Deployables, and PTT

Expanded Band 14 with a focus on rural areas, tribal communities, and sites where public safety said they needed coverage



Working with public safety

Helped public safety integrate FirstNet into operations through after action reviews and preplanning activities

In collaboration with public safety stakeholders, completed an afteraction review of the Christmas Day bombing in Nashville

Led a working group on wildfire response that gathered lessons learned from public safety entities



Driving the future

Conducted rigorous oversight of the FirstNet contract, including delivery of Task Orders for investments

Released an updated FirstNet
Authority Roadmap with priorities
reflective of the short- and long-term
perspectives of first responders

1,200+ engagements across all states/territories, levels of gov't and disciplines provided feedback on FirstNet's operational impact, including pandemic response



FIRST RESPONDER NETWORK AUTHORITY FINANCE COMMITTEE RESOLUTION 28 RECOMMENDATION ON FISCAL YEAR 2022 BUDGET

August 18, 2021

WHEREAS, the Finance Committee of the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet Authority) Board (Finance Committee) has reviewed the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget as presented by Senior Leadership;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Finance Committee hereby recommends that the First Responder Network Authority Board (Board) approve Senior Leadership's Fiscal Year 2022 Budget of \$252,840,526 for the three major funding categories of (1) FirstNet Authority Operations; (2) Operational Contingency Reserve; and (3) Reinvestment in Network Enhancement Fund; and \$103,448 in Network Construction Fund carry over balance to absorb any unforeseen and necessary adjustments when the fiscal year end reconciliation is performed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Finance Committee recommends that the Board approve Senior Leadership's Fiscal Year 2022 FirstNet Authority Operations Budget of \$79,325,000 on an obligations basis (plus, with advance notice to the Board, up to a 10% management reallocation allowance from the Reserve Allocation in the event of unplanned and extraordinary circumstances); Operational Contingency Reserve Allocation of \$79,325,000 (an amount equal to the Operations Budget for Fiscal Year 2022); Reinvestment in Network Enhancement Fund Allocation of \$94,087,078; and \$103,448 to the NCF on an obligations basis. Should the FirstNet Authority receive any additional sources of income in Fiscal Year 2022, excluding income from PSTF and NCF, they will be added to the Reinvestment in Network Enhancement Fund funding category;

WHEREAS, the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet Authority) Board (Board) has reviewed the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget as presented by Senior Leadership;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves a Fiscal Year 2022 Budget of \$252,840,526 for the three (3) major funding categories of (1) FirstNet Authority Operations; (2) Operational Contingency Reserve; and (3) Reinvestment in Network Enhancement Fund; and \$103,448 in Network Construction Fund carry over balance to absorb any unforeseen and necessary adjustments when the fiscal year end reconciliation is performed.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board approves allocation of the Fiscal Year 2022 Budget as follows: FirstNet Authority Operations Budget of \$79,325,000 on an obligations basis (plus, with advance notice to the Board, up to a 10% management reallocation allowance from the Reserve Allocation in the event of unplanned and extraordinary circumstances); Operational Contingency Reserve Allocation of \$79,325,000 (an amount equal to the Operations Budget for Fiscal Year 2022); Reinvestment in Network Enhancement Fund Allocation of \$94,087,078 on an obligations basis; and \$103,448 NCF carry-over balance on an obligations basis. Should the FirstNet Authority receive any additional sources of income in Fiscal Year 2022, excluding income from PSTF and NCF, they will be added to the Reinvestment in Network Enhancement Fund funding category;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board authorizes Senior Leadership to enter into the necessary agreements to meet Fiscal Year 2022 strategic objectives, consistent with Board Resolutions 78 and 100;

 on ICAM's influence on applications heavily used by public safety




Telehealth Strike Team



Devices

- 335 devices in ecosystem
- Increase of 28 in past quarter
- 81% Band 14 capable
- Smartphones, Rugged Handhelds, Laptops, Tablets, IoT M2M-Broadband



Applications

- 172 apps in App Catalog
- Increase of 10 in past quarter
- New apps and solutions for public safety
- Secure messaging, LMR interoperability, officer safety and wellness
