BOARD RESOLUTION 121

EXTENSION OF CHIEF CHRIS LOMBARD'S APPOINTMENT AS PSAC CHAIR

December 10, 2025

WHEREAS, the First Responder Network Authority (FirstNet Authority) was established under the Middle Class Tax Relief and Job Creation Act of 2012 (Act), which mandates that the FirstNet Authority take all actions necessary to ensure the building, deployment, and operation of the nationwide public safety broadband network;

WHEREAS, the Act requires the FirstNet Authority to establish a standing public safety advisory committee (PSAC) to assist in carrying out its duties and responsibilities;

WHEREAS, on June 3, 2014, the FirstNet Authority Board adopted Resolution 59 approving the PSAC Charter, defining the role of the PSAC and providing a management structure;

WHEREAS, on May 5, 2021, the FirstNet Authority Board adopted Resolution 109, amending the PSAC Charter;

WHEREAS, the PSAC Charter states that the PSAC Chair shall serve a one-year term and may be reappointed for two additional consecutive terms, but subsequent appointments beyond three years require FirstNet Authority Board approval;

WHEREAS, Chief Chris Lombard has served as PSAC Chair since October 2021, and his reappointment requires FirstNet Authority Board approval;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Board hereby approves the extension of Chief Lombard's current term as PSAC Chair through December 31, 2026.
