WHEREAS, Teri Takai has served admirably as a founding, and the longest standing, member of the FirstNet Authority Board since its inception in 2012 and as an influential member of the Board's Governance and Personnel Committee and the Public Safety Advocacy (formerly known as the Consultation and Outreach) Committee;

WHEREAS, Teri Takai has notably represented the state and local government communities, and her expertise in government information technology and her extensive experience as the Chief Information Officer for the states of Michigan and California have been invaluable to the FirstNet Authority Board;

Identifies the *priorities that will guide investments* and other opportunities based on FirstNet Authority analysis




FirstNet Authority Roadmap Process




Overall Public Safety Engagement for the FirstNet Authority Roadmap




Coverage and Capacity Overview

Situational Awareness Overview






<u>Vision</u>





FY 2019 Cumulative Financial Results – Operations Budget




Actual Obligations
